Of course there are studies on individual emperors, dynasties and aspects of the imperial office/role, but there remains no equivalent to Fergus Millar's *The Emperor in the Roman World*. The proposed volume takes inspiration for its title and scope) The oddity of a lack of a general study of the Byzantine emperor is compounded by the fact that a series of books devoted to Byzantine empresses was published in the late twentieth and early twenty-first centuries. Thus it is appropriate to turn the spotlight on the emperor. Themes covered by the contributors include the imperial court and the emperor's men; imperial duties and the emperor as ruler; imperial literature (the emperor as subject and author); and the material emperor, including imperial images and spaces. The volume fills a need in the field and the market, and also brings new and cutting-edge approaches to the study of the Byzantine emperor. It offers an unconventional view of Casanova as a benevolent lover of women, an ardent believer in the Enlightenment, who grew from a sickly Venetian infant, abandoned by his actress mother, to become a spirited voluptuary
