statistics. In *Scouting and Scoring*, Christopher Phillips rejects these simplistic divisions. He shows how both scouts and scorers rely on numbers, bureaucracy, trust, and human labor to make sound judgments about the value of baseball players. Tracing baseball's story from the nineteenth century to today, Phillips explains that the sport was one of the earliest fields to introduce numerical analysis, and new methods of data collection were supposed to enable teams to replace scouting with scoring. But that's not how things turned out. From the

invention of official scorers and Statcast to the creation of the Major League Scouting Bureau, *Scouting and Scoring* reveals the inextricable connections between human expertise and data science, and offers an entirely fresh understanding of baseball. Thirteen young Boy Scouts climbed up to Half Dome, but only twelve came back down. Discovering what happened to the missing scout is Nick Falconi's task. He has been hired by Patrick Toomey to begin this quest. And what a quest it is! He interviews artists, business men, hippies and priests to get to the facts.

Yet the most difficult and most irrefutable fact is that the mystery of this missing scout occurred sixty-one years ago. Rick Perry examines in detail the issues that have led to the attacks on Scouting and the forces in American society that have organized and carried out those attacks.
