Immer wieder fällt Lehrern, Eltern und Nachhilfelehrern auf, dass Schüler besonders bei Lückentexten willkürlich Verbformen in unpassenden Zeiten einsetzen. Dabei folgt der Gebrauch der Zeitformen im Englischen, anders als im Deutschen, ganz strikten Regeln, die meist mit Signalwörtern deutlich werden. Da diese aber nicht immer deutlich genug mit der jeweiligen Zeitform verknüpft werden, sind sie für die Schüler eben keine Signalwörter, die eine ganz bestimmte Zeit erfordern, sondern einfach nur Wörter im Text. Mit diesen Arbeitsblättern werden die englischen Zeitformen nun mit deutlichen Signalwörtern gelernt und abgespeichert. Zusätzlich gibt es am Ende Tabellen, in denen alle Zeitformen mit ihren jeweiligen Signalwörtern aufgelistet sind. Diese sollten ausgedruckt und gut sichtbar aufgehängt werden, so dass sie während des Lernprozesses stets zur Verfügung stehen.

Das freie Schreiben nimmt im Englischunterricht zu Recht einen immer größeren Stellenwert ein. Mit kreativen und vielfältigen Schreibaufgaben werden Schüler ermunert, sich auf Englisch auszudrücken. Schließlich motivieren selbst geschriebene Geschichten, Zeitungsartikel oder Gedichte die Schüler dazu, sich in der Fremdsprache auszudrücken und somit wichtige sprachliche Kompetenzen zu schulen. In diesem Heft finden Sie abwechslungsreiche Schreibaufgaben: Die Schüler lernen u.a., worauf man bei der Verwendung der direkten Rede achten muss, wie man Konjunktionen nutzt, um Sätze geschickt zu verbinden und wie man einen argumentativen Text schreibt.

Anita Lahey's second collection, Spinning Side Kick,is a hard-knuckled look at the other half. These lively poems mix a girl-about-town cockiness with an all-too-rare emotional honesty about men, love, and relationships. Whether the subject is a one-man chimney demolition, the lifelong fidelity of seahorses, a lover at war in Afghanistan or a kickboxing match, Lahey confronts the enduring disconnect between the sexes in a language that is slangy and quick, punctuated with jabs. She eyes those moments—in a day, in a life—when the normal clues we rely on disappear, shifting the line between domesticity and danger. In Spinning Side Kick, a talented poet returns with sharper aim.

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First seeing action in the wake of the German invasion of the USSR in June 1941, the Royal Rumanian Air Force had been allied to the Luftwaffe since the Romanian government signed a Tripartite Pact with Germany and Italy in November 1940. This book reveals how, despite suffering heavy losses to the numerically superior Russian forces, the Rumanians inflicted even greater casualties on the communists. Locked in bitter conflict with the Soviets until September 1944, when the Red Army poured across the Rumanian frontier and forced an armistice, the modest fighter force claimed 1500+ kills using primarily Bf 109's. This sumptuously illustrated volume analyzes artists' representations of angels and demons and heaven and hell from the Judeo-Christian tradition and describes how these artistic portrayals evolved over time. As with other books in the Guide to Imagery series, the goal of this volume is to help contemporary art enthusiasts decode the symbolic meanings in the great masterworks of Western Art. The first chapter traces the development of images of the Creation and the Afterworld from descriptions of them in the Scriptures through their evolution in later literary and philosophical works. The following two chapters examine artists' depictions of the two paths that humans may take, the path of evil or the path of salvation, and the punishments or rewards found on each. A chapter on the Judgment Day and the end of the world explores portrayals of the mysterious worlds between life and death and in the afterlife. Finally, the author looks at images of angelic and demonic beings themselves and how they came to be portrayed with the physical attributes—wings, halos, horns, and cloven hooves—with which we are now so familiar. Thoroughly researched by and expert in the field of iconography, Angels and Demons in Art will delight readers with an interest in art or religious symbolism.

In this acclaimed memoir, Mezlekia recalls his boyhood in the arid city of Jijiga, Ethiopia, and his journey to manhood during the 1970s and 1980s. He traces his personal evolution from child to soldier—forced at the age of eighteen to join a guerrilla army. And he describes the hardships that consumed Ethiopia after the fall of Emperor Haile Selassie and the rise to power of the communist junta, in whose terror thousands of Ethiopians died. Part autobiography and part social history, Notes from the Hyena's Belly offers an unforgettable portrait of Ethiopia, and of Africa, during the defining and turbulent years of the last century.
